- **Building the international network of hydrogen advocates by holding Workshops and Executive Meetings around the world**
 - Typically two Executive Meetings/year
 - This public workshop is the first for PATH, sponsored by HESS
- **Assisting partners in public outreach, government policy, advocacy, and codes & standards development**
 - Joint Statement at COP15 Climate Change Conference in Copenhagen – November 2010
 - New Delhi workshop on codes and standards – August 2010
- **Writing a report on the state of the global hydrogen economy – ongoing**
- **Helping other countries form associations – as desired**
- **Providing international recognition to all PATH associations**
- **Sharing best association management, governance and program practices**
- **Helping associations publish and communicate good information developed by other associations**

- Share public education and other outreach communications among partners
