"Stakeholders" include without limitation corporations, partnerships and other private businesses, academic and research institutions, and governmental and quasi-governmental agencies, involved in the production, storage, transportation, utilization and/or regulation of hydrogen, or in research directly relating thereto. Only one association will be admitted to membership from any one country.*

*For any country without an association that qualifies for membership, an academic institution, non-governmental organization, or a government agency responsible for the promotion of hydrogen and the development of the hydrogen industry in that country, may apply for interim membership, provided that it is actively promoting the establishment of a qualified association and planning a timely application for membership in PATH.*
